(February 3, 2007) — **Lumetrics wins its largest deal**

Lumetrics, a Henrietta maker of precision measuring equipment, said it has won a contract with a large food and beverage company. Lumetrics said it could not identify the client or the exact value of the deal, but said the order was more than \$250,000 and is its largest ever. The customer will use Lumetrics equipment to measure the thickness of food packaging.

Lumetrics, a startup founded with technology licensed from Eastman Kodak Co., employs 10 people and expects to grow to 17 workers by the end of the year.
